We have extra buckets of soap and softener, extra pods of detergent and dishwasher detergent, one set of dryer sheets, one stain remover, and a few scent boosters.
- Our Veterans Day program will be November 10th at 8:30. All Veterans are invited to attend a breakfast before the program. We welcome any Veteran or their family members to our program that morning.
- Picture retakes will be THIS Friday. All students who were not here on picture day will need to have their picture taken. If you were not happy with your child's original pictures, you can have them get retakes on Friday.
- Several classrooms will be having their Halloween parties this Friday. Keep in mind students should not wear their costume to school. If they are going to dress up for the party they will need to bring their costume in a separate bag. Also, students should be reminded that their costumes should be appropriate for school and follow the school dress code (no horror items, weapons, proper clothing, etc.) If they have any questions, please see Mr Rohrig.
