Information from the Principal's Office

- Mr. Rohrig is currently the Interim Superintendent of Schools and the Elementary Principal. To help with his responsibilities, Mr. Ted Ahaus is also the Interim Elementary Principal. Mr. Rohrig and Mr. Ahaus will be teaming up to lead JCDE. Please join me in welcoming Mr. Ahaus to our community.
- There have been a few changes to school operations. I want to highlight a couple this week.
 - Student pick up will happen at the back of the gym. If you are picking your child up, you will have to check in with a staff member at the back entrance. A staff member will radio another staff member in the building. As you pull around to the back of the building we will get your student ready for you to pick them up in the back. This should help with traffic, parents can remain in their cars, and students are safest.
 - We have a new attendance policy for student absences. JCD has partnered with Ripley County Probation with the Attend and Engage Program (AEP). Parents can call in 6 times for an absence. **Please make sure you call in if your student is going to be absent.** Parents will be sent letters after 3, 6, 9, and 12 unexcused absences.
- THIS WEEK JCDE PTO will pass out the Fall Laundry Soap Order Forms. This is a great fundraiser that helps our students and school. The PTO is very active with our students. They provide school supplies to our students, provide transportation to field trips, and provide many other community and school projects.
