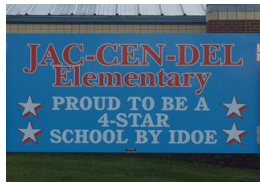

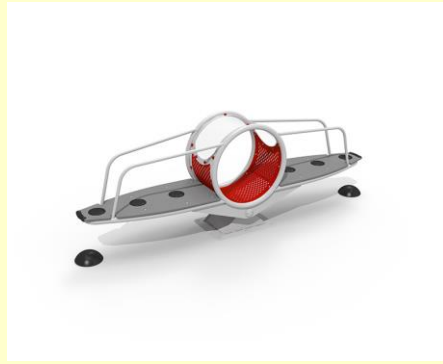

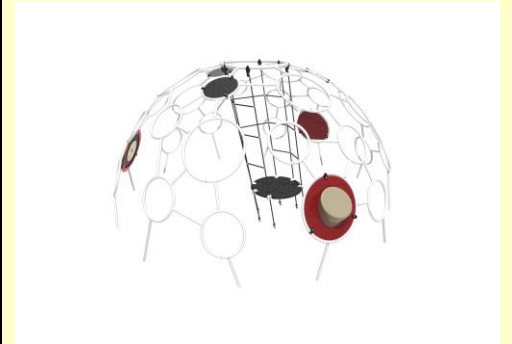
**CHECK OUT OUR NEW PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT**
