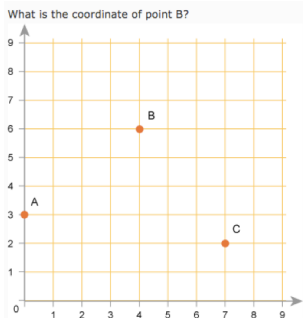
Helpful Vocabulary

DO YOU KNOW HOW TO FIND OUT IF SCHOOL IS ON A DELAY OR CLOSED???

I want to remind parents that there are several methods to be aware of school closings or delays. Here are some of the preferred methods:

Twitter: Follow @JCDElementary on Twitter and receive the information instantly

Facebook: School closing and delays are posted there by Mr Rohrig

Radio: 103.9 WRBI and 99.3 will have school closings and delays

This allows students to practice technology enhanced items for ISTEP+ in April. They will not have to do these types of problems until the second testing session.
