Information from the Principal's Office

- We will host our Open House on Monday from 5:30 to 7:30. Students are welcome to bring their parents and their families to this event. We will have light refreshments available for all attendees. We will also pass out our iPads to third through sixth graders. If you have not completed the Respectable Use Policy and Protection Plan paperwork, you will need to do so at Open House. You can always change your selection on the Protection Plan for your child. Miss Tammy and Mrs. Flo Wagner will be available to take book fees and answer other questions if needed.
- There have been a few changes to the student handbook. I want to highlight a couple this week.
 - There are clear definitions of tardy and absence. We are also implementing a policy on tardies this year in hopes to limit the number of tardies our students accumulate.
 - This year we will be operating on weighted grades. Our quizzes and tests will count for 80% of their overall grade. Homework and other classwork will count for 20% of their overall grade. This will help everyone be better informed on the progress of their child throughout the school year.
 - Students are allowed to wear sandals to school but they need to have a strap on the back of them. We want our students to be Safe, Organized, Accountable, and Respectful. We are taking a proactive approach to making sure they can be safe in the school.
- Once again we will be having Late Arrival Days this school year. Our first Late Arrival Day will be August 16th. Transportation will be running two hours behind on those days.
- We will continue to have Latch Key this year. We will now be offering morning Latch Key. Students can be dropped off in the cafeteria starting at 6:30 am. Student need to be signed by parents in the morning. Students will need to be signed out by parents at night. The cost of morning Latch Key is \$2.00 a student per morning. The cost of afternoon Latch Key is \$3.00 a student per evening.

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
