Information from the Principal's Office

- There have been a few changes to the student handbook. I want to highlight a couple this week.
 - There are clear definitions of tardy and absence. We are also implementing a policy on tardies this year in hopes to limit the number of tardies our students accumulate.
 - This year we will be operating on weighted grades. Our quizzes and tests will count for 80% of their overall grade. Homework and other classwork will count for 20% of their overall grade. This will help everyone be better informed on the progress of their child throughout the school year.
 - Students are allowed to wear sandals to school but they need to have a strap on the back of them. We want our students to be Safe, Organized, Accountable, and Respectful. We are taking a proactive approach to making sure they can be safe in the school.
- Once again we will be having Late Arrival Days this school year. Our first Late Arrival Day will be August 16th. Transportation will be running two hours behind on those days.
- We will continue to have Latch Key this year. We will now be offering morning Latch Key. Students can be dropped off in the cafeteria starting at 6:30 am. **IF YOU DROP YOUR CHILD OFF BEFORE 7:30 YOU WILL BE CHARGED \$2.00 FOR LATCH KEY.** Student need to be signed by parents in the morning. Students will need to be signed out by parents at night. The cost of morning Latch Key is \$2.00 a student per morning. The cost of afternoon Latch Key is \$3.00 a student per evening.
- JCDE has a YouTube Channel. Mr. Rohrig has been reading books to students and uploading them to the YouTube Channel. You can follow the channel on YouTube by subscribing to MrRohrigJCDE.
- Next Monday we will be having a solar eclipse. The school will be taking precautions and providing learning opportunities for the eclipse. Please be on the lookout for more details and information.
- This week your K-2nd grade student will be bringing home a permission slip for our trip to Columbus to visit Ivy Tech, Purdue Polytechnic, and IUPUC. This will be a great opportunity for students to see future opportunities in their educational career.

This Wednesday we will have our first Late Arrival Day. We will still offer Latch Key from 6:30 to 7:30 am for a fee of \$2.00 a student. If you drop your child off between 7:30 and 9:45 there is no charge on Late Arrival Days. Transportation will be running two hours behind normal time on Wednesday. We thank you for your cooperation!
